- A. The bidder shall declare that the tax so collected from the Corporation will be duly discharged either by using input tax creditor paid as per provisions under GST Act.
 - B. The bidder shall declare that the supply date as mentioned in the invoice will be disclosed correctly in the relevant monthly return (such as GSTR-1, GSTR-2, GSTR-3, GSTR-3B and other relevant forms).
 - C. The bidder shall also agree that he will compensate for input tax credit if not allowed to Corporation due to non-disclosure or improper disclosure in the aforesaid returns as required under GST Act.
 - D. If the bidder is unregistered under GST Act., in that case the bidder should submit an undertaking that his turnover is within the threshold limit.
 - E. Anti-profiteering clause: The bidder should declare that the benefit on account of change of rate of GST and input tax credit will be passed on to Corporation by way of reducing the contact prices and there shall not be any double taxation.
 - F. As and when GST Law requires deduction of withholding tax i.e., TDS under section51 GST Law, Corporation shall deduct such tax as per prevailed provisions.
 - G. The bidder of goods shall issue waybill as and when required as per provisions of GST law for supply of goods.
3. The tender document will be available from the web site **www.ophwc.com** and same may be downloaded to be used for tender offer. The tender paper cost as mentioned in

6.The authority will not be held responsible for any technical snag or network failure during downloading the tender documents.

7.The bidders shall submit proof of deposit of the tender paper cost, along with copies of the following documents: Firm/Company Registration Certificate, valid GST Registration Certificate, audited balance sheets and turnover certificate issued by a Chartered Accountant (with UDIN), Income Tax Return (ITR) acknowledgements for the last three financial years, PAN card, ESI Registration Certificate, EPF Registration Certificate, and proof of execution of similar nature of work supported by copies of work orders and corresponding completion certificates. All such documents shall be enclosed with the bid, failing which the bid shall be summarily rejected. Documents submitted in any previous tender/contract shall not be considered valid for this tender.

8. The Bidders/Contractors having any type of adverse remarks from Govt./PSU regarding past work experience shall not eligible for apply of tender. This will be the part of the affidavit to be furnished otherwise the bid shall be rejected.

9. To participate in the tender the bidder must furnish the copy of GSTR-1 of preceding months of tender date otherwise the bid shall be rejected.

10. An affidavit is to be furnished by the bidder at the time of submitting bid document that he is not blacklisted / defaulter contractor or Firm etc. in support of the tender otherwise the bid shall be rejected.

11. The bidder should have its Local office in Odisha (proof of Address may be submitted) or Undertaking for establishment of an office, within 7 days of award of the contract.

12.Bidder must be a profit-making firm/company with a minimum Avg. turnover of Rs. 6.0 Crore in the last three financial years i.e 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25. Turn over

certificate must be submitted certified by the CA with authorized UDIN must be submitted as a proof otherwise the bid shall be rejected.

13.The bidding document should be super scribed “Name of the work & Tender No and Name of the bidder.”

14.EMD - The tender document shall be accompanied with EMD as mentioned in the Column- 3 of the above table in shape of DD/TDR/FDR pledged in favour of “The Odisha State Police Housing & Welfare Corporation Ltd, Bhubaneswar” failing which the tender shall be rejected. The EMD of the successful tenderer will be refunded after The EMD shall be released after successful completion of the entire project in all respect, upon certification by the concerned User Authority and will not carry any interest. The EMD of the unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded after completion of the tender process.

15. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason thereof and can impose any conditions as deemed proper before finalisation of tender. No claim, whatsoever, shall be admissible for the alleged loss/damages suffered by bidders on account of such rejections.

16.Bids submitted otherwise than in the manner prescribed in the tender document shall be rejected.

20. All the information as called for in the tender document should be submitted truly, clearly, legible, transparently, unambiguously and without the use of abbreviations. It shall be submitted in English only.

21.All the crucial figures, like rates and amount should be written in figures followed by words in a bracket correctly.

22.There shall be no over writing shall be allowed in the tender documents. Any corrections must be duly initialed and stamped by the authorized signatory, failing which the bid may be rejected.

23.The original documents of the successful lowest bidders will be verified at the office of the undersigned within five days after opening of the bid failing which his tender is liable for rejection.

24.All the rates and amounts shall be quoted in Indian Rupee and shall be presumed to be in Indian Rupee only unless specifically permitted to be quoted otherwise in this tender document.

25.Each page of this tender document should be signed by the bidder with seal in token of having read, understood and accepted the terms and conditions of this contract.

26.Use separate piece of paper where the space provided in the formats in this tender document for submission of information is not sufficient.

27.All information submitted or supplied in the formats of this tender document shall be presumed to be true to the best of knowledge of bidder.

28.If the last date for receipt of the tender/bid turns out to be a holiday, it will automatically be extended to next working day.

29.A bid submitted cannot be withdrawn. The bidder or his authorized representative (one person only) will be allowed to be present at the time of opening of tenders. They will not participate in the discussions. Clarification sought, if any may be provided by them.

30. Conditional Tenders will not be accepted and shall be rejected.

31. Selection Criteria: The tender shall be submitted in two parts (Technical Bid and Financial Bid) as per double cover system. Only technically qualified bidders shall participate in a PoC, which is a purely practical demonstration of the complete solution. Only bidders who successfully qualify in the PoC shall proceed to the financial bid opening.

After careful observation, Government has been pleased to abolish the extant provisions of threshold negative bid caps (14.99%) introduced in Appendix-IX, Clause 36 of OPWD Code Volume-II in the procurement of works undertaken by the Govt of Odisha and its agencies to Ensure the procurement process results in a viable and successful manner.

Sub- Clarification on works Department Office Memorandum No.173 dt. 03.01.2026 regarding Amendment of Codal and Contractual provisions.

The following clarifications are issued on Works Department Office Memorandum No. 173, dt. 03.01.2026

1.The phrase” to abolish the extant provisions of threshold negative bid caps (14.99%) introduced.....” in the first para of the Works Department OM No.173 dt. 03.01.2026 may be read as “..... to abolish the extant provisions of threshold negative

bid caps of 15% introduced vide Works Department OM No.12366/W Dt. 08.11.2013 and amended vide Works Department OM No. 1437 dt, 31.01.2023.....”

2. if more than one bid is quoted (decimal up to two numbers will be taken for all practical purposes), either at the estimated cost put to tender or less than the estimated cost put to tender, the tender accepting Authority will finalize the tender through a transparent lottery system, where all bidders/their authorized representatives, Asst. Manager (Accounts), Electrical Division and Tender Inviting Authority will remain present.”

3. If the rate quoted by the SC and ST Category Contractors comes to the rate quoted by the L1 bidder (decimal up to two numbers will be taken for all practical purposes) after availing 10% price preference as per Para 2 of Works Department Resolution No.27748 dated. 11.10.1977, the tender shall be finalized by the tender accepting authority through a transparent lottery system along with other categories of contractors, where all bidders/their authorized representatives, Asst. Manager (Accounts), Electrical Division and Tender Inviting Authority will remain present.”

33. Additional performance Security:

Additional performance Security shall be obtained from the bidder when the bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender. In such an event, the successful bidder who have quoted less bid price/rates than the estimated cost put to tender shall have to furnish as per Works Deptt. Office Memorandum No.07764600022025 173 /W., Bhubaneswar Dt.03.01.2026 as Additional Performance Security in shape of TDR/FDR pledged in favour of “The Project Manager, Electrical Division, The Odisha State Police Housing & Welfare Corporation Ltd, Bhubaneswar” is to be submitted by the successful bidder who shall deposit the same within seven (7) days of opening of bid failing which the bid of the successful bidder would be cancelled and the security deposit would be forfeited. If permissible in law further proceedings for black listing would be initiated.

Additional performance security shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:

I. where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid, no additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.

II. where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid, the additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;

III. where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid, the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the

bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;

IV. The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.

V. The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.

VI. Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. If, after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.

34. CCTV cameras, NVRs, and PoE switches shall comply with applicable quality standards and must be certified by STQC/BIS/CE/UL/FCC, as applicable to the equipment. ***Chinese brands are strictly prohibited.*** Supporting documentary evidence shall be submitted along with the Technical Bid. The minimum technical specifications for cameras and PoE switches are provided in Annexure-B, and the offered equipment must comply with these specifications in addition to any other applicable requirements.

35. The proposed software platform, analytics engine, command-and-control system, or application software shall comply with the security and quality standards prescribed by the Standardisation Testing and Quality Certification Directorate (STQC), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. If any required STQC certification is under process at the time of bid submission, the bidder shall submit documentary proof of the application as part of the technical bid. Additionally, the bidder shall submit a declaration or authorization letter from the VMS and Video Analytics Software providers, explicitly authorizing the bidder to participate in and execute this tender.

36. Items of which specifications are not mentioned in tender document should be of

ISI/Industrial standards marked or according to applicable Governments Norms.

37. Any illegible documents submitted by the bidder in the technical bid document shall not be considered.

38. Authority of OPHWC reserves the right to ask clarifications on the already submitted documents by the bidder. At any stage if found the bidder has submitted any false documents or suppress any information then in this case the bid will be rejected and no correspondence will be made.

39. The authority reserves the right to cancel any or all bids without assigning any reason. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof & can impose any conditions as deemed proper before finalization of tender.

40. The bidder shall be responsible for finalizing the complete network connectivity layout diagram covering cameras, PoE, PA System, NVR, VMS, analytics application, and the Control Room as per the scope, prior to commencement of the work. The same shall be submitted to this office, and a hard copy shall be displayed at the ICCC (Town PS) for easy understanding and smooth maintenance during the entire period.

41. The OPHWC shall have no liability, financial or otherwise, for any harm/ damage/ injury caused to the manpower/machinery deployed by the firm while performing work of this Department. Neither the firm nor its workers shall have any claim on this Department for compensation or financial assistance on this account.

42. From the commencement of the contract to the completion of the same, they are to be under the contractor's charge. The contractor is to be held responsible to make good all injuries, damages and repairs occasioned or rendered necessary to the same by fire or other causes and they hold the OPHWC harmless for any claims for injuries to person or structural damage to property happening from any neglect, default, want of proper care or misconduct on the part of the contractor or any one in his employment during the execution of the contract. Also, no claim shall be entertained for loss due to earthquake, flood, cyclone, epidemic, riot or any other calamity whether natural or incidental damages so caused will have to be made good by the bidder at his own cost till completion of entire Contract period.

43. Any damages caused by natural calamities should be done by the contractor at his own cost. The OPHWC will not be any way responsible for the same and will not pay any cost towards the repair done by the contractor till completion of Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract period.

44. If the bidder has a relative employee as an Officer in the rank of Deputy Manager & above in OPHWC, he shall inform the same in the bid mentioning the exact details in a covering letter along with the tender, failing which his bid will not be considered (ANNEXURE-E). Also, if the fact of relationship subsequently comes to light, his

contract will be rescinded. The bid security or the performance security will be forfeited and he shall be liable to make good any loss or damage resulting from such cancellation. In case the bidder has no relationship with any of the officers mentioned above he shall have to furnish with his bid a certificate (**ANNEXURE-D**).

45. Responsibility for Completion of the Entire Work: Any additional hardware or software not explicitly mentioned in the specifications/BOQ but required for successful implementation and completion of the solution shall be provided by the bidder at no additional cost.

46. The bidder's personnel shall not divulge or disclose to any person any details of the project, the user office, operational processes, technical know-how, security arrangements, or administrative and organizational matters, all of which are confidential in nature. It shall be binding on the firm not to disclose the network architecture of the said work or any other related information to any individual, group, or firm, which may compromise the security of the User Authority.

47. Irrespective of turnover, the contractor shall submit the E-invoice (in form of B2B against GSTIN 21AABCT7853 N2ZZ) mandatorily before acceptance of payment.

48. No claim can be made due to some unforeseen delay for release of payment.

49. Payment: Advance payment /part payment will not be entertained before completion/ handing over the work to the concerned authority. Payment of bill will be made as per actual basis only after successful completion of the entire period of the project in all respect, upon certification by the concerned User Authority.

50. Performance Security: The successful tenderer shall be required to deposit 10% of the contract value in the form of DD/FDR/TDR as security money after adjusting the EMD deposited and same will be released after successful completion of the Contract period and will not carry any interest.

51. Each bidder shall submit only one bid for one package. A bid is said to be complete if accompanied by cost of bid document and appropriate bid security.

52. Failure to complete the Contract satisfactorily may lead to forfeiture of EMD and blacklisting of the contractor/firm.

53. The authorities are not bound to accept the lowest quoted rate.

54. Terms and conditions of this tender document cannot be negotiated for variations.

55. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all tender in whole or part without assigning any reason and can impose any other condition(s) as deemed proper before or in course of finalisation of the tender.

56.The approved tender may be cancelled by the authority any time during validity without assigning any reason thereof and no claim can lie against OPHWC for such cancellation.

57. Time line:The bidder shall ensure that the entire work is completed within the stipulated timeline, and all systems under the scope are fully operational on or before 08.06.2026. The bidder shall further ensure that the systems are maintained in fully operational condition throughout the entire contract period as specified in the tender. Considering that the Ratha Yatra comprises multiple sub-events, the deployment and integration of both the CCTV Surveillance System and Public Address (PA) System shall be carried out in a phased manner on a priority basis, as per location details to be provided by the User Authority.

However, at any stage during review by the User Authority, if the progress or targets achieved by the L1 bidder are found to be unsatisfactory, thereby raising concerns regarding the bidder's capability to complete the entire work within the stipulated timeline, the authority reserves the right to take appropriate action as per the terms and conditions of the contract.

58. TERMINATION: The Contract can be terminated on the following grounds:

1. The bidder is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.
2. During the period of contract, if it is found that the bidder is not providing proper service/ charging by fraudulent manner or otherwise, agreement will be terminated with immediate effect and the whole Bank Guarantee/ Security Deposit or part thereof shall be forfeited.
3. The authority reserves the right to terminate this contract at any time by informing the bidder in advance without assigning any reasons thereof.
4. In the event of termination of the contract, the bidder shall hand over all equipment in a fully functional condition. In case the Service Provider fails to hand over the equipment in proper condition, the authority reserves the right to arrange rectification/restoration through a third party at the risk and cost of the bidder. The expenses so incurred shall be recovered from the bidder's pending bills and/or Security Deposit. In addition, applicable penalty clauses shall be imposed as per the terms of the agreement.

59.The bidder should ensure that all the work of "Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of IP-Based CCTV Cameras at 175 Nos. Locations for Uninterrupted Surveillance and Public Address System at 28 Nos. Locations in Puri Town and its Outskirts, along with Setup of Command Control Room and Sub-Control Rooms at 7 Nos. Locations on Rental Basis for the Period from 08.06.2026 to 27.07.2026 on the Occasion of Ratha Yatra–2026" is completed in the prescribed time and in no case the contract or firm may do any activity which may disturb any authority/inmates to work/hamper the official duties of user authority.

60. Items mentioned in BOQ of tender documents are approximate quantity. CCTV Surveillance System, PA System and other items mentioned may be increased or decreased as per site condition and subject to availability of locations as per Annexure – A. However, the payment will be made as per actual basis.

61. Penalty: If the bidder fails to complete the entire work within the stipulated timeline or commits any breach of contract, a penalty by way of compensation at the rate of 0.5% of the contract value per day of delay (calculated on a per-day basis) shall be imposed. Provided that the total amount of compensation for delay to be paid under this condition shall not exceed 10 % of the work order value.

62. In the event that the L1 bidder fails to execute the work or the contract is cancelled for any reason whatsoever, the L2 bidder may be given an opportunity to execute the same work, subject to acceptance of the L1 rates and compliance with the terms and conditions of the tender. The L2 bidder shall also be required to complete the entire scope of work within the original timeline specified for the L1 bidder, following due procedure.

- Two Control Rooms shall be made functional at the Integrated Control Room, Town Police Station, and the Traffic Control Room, Kumbharapada Police Station. One Mini Control Room shall be established at Gundicha Badi Outpost, and four terminals shall be installed at IPS Mess, Temple Outpost, Circuit House, and GRP Control Room.
- All existing cameras installed at Jagannath Temple and Gundicha Temple shall be integrated with the Integrated Control Room located at Town Police Station in coordination with concerned authority.
